Grading System and Re-registration Rules for IIIT Kalyani

(i) For every course taken by a student he/she is assigned a grade based on his/her combined performance over the semester in all the assessments in that course. These grades are described by the letters EX, A, B, C, D, P, F, each of which indicates a relative performance of the student in the class. A student passes the course if he/she gets any grade other than F.

(ii) A student is awarded the fail grade F if his/her performance in the course is poor. He/She is eligible for the end-semester examination, only once, during the supplementary examinations held during summer vacation. The students who will clear the **supplementary examination** (any grade other than P and F) **will be awarded one grade less than the actual grade awarded** to the student. If absent for such re-examination for any reason, the student will be awarded an “FR” grade.

A student with an FR grade is not eligible for re-examination in that course and has to re-register for that course whenever it is offered.

(iii) F grade will be awarded in cases where in the opinion of the instructor, the student hasn't had adequate academic exposure to the course and should therefore repeat the course. **F grade may also be awarded in cases of minor malpractice in examinations/assessments.**

A student, whose in-semester performance is very poor, may be awarded the 'F' grade by the instructors, even if he/she had missed the end-semester examination due to any reason.
