In the coming session the intake of students in Computer Science and Engineering has been finalised to 130. Indian Institute of Information Technology Is now approaching to 4th year and in accordance with the students' strength the total number of students will be 520 in 4 years and this strength will continue for the future years. As per NIT Rules the ratio of Students and Faculty is 12:1 I.e. keeping In view the students strength 520 the number of faculty is required 44. Similarly, the ratio of Faculty and Non-Faculty is 1:1.1 i.e. total strength of nonfaculty Is becoming 48. After due deliberation the Committee recommended the full strength of Faculty and Non Faculty, as under, which can be filled up as early as possible for smooth functioning of
