The Indian Institute of Information Technology Kalyani has been setup with an objective to produce best-in-class human resources in Computer Science and Engineering (CSE) and to harness the multidimensional facets of CSE in various domains. IIIT Kalyani strives to evolve into a world-class academic institution with the highest quality of education and research facilities and produce industry ready CSE graduates to meet the industry demands. The institute will act as a catalyst in fostering an innovative entrepreneur-focused ecosystem to ensure that new products, solutions and IP are created in the State taking advantage of the intellectual capital of the State.

IIIT Kalyani has been set up at Kalyani, West Bengal by Government of India (MHRD), Government of West Bengal and industry partners on a Not-for-profit **Public** Private Partnership (N-PPP) basis. being funded in the ratio of 50:35:15, respectively, by the above three parties. Additionally, the Government of West Bengal has lent support to the institute by granting 50 acres of land for setting up the Campus. The industry partners of IIIT Kalyani are Coal India Ltd. and Rolta Foundation for the present. The institute is run by the Governing Body of IIIT Kalyani whose members include the representatives of Government of India (MHRD), Government of West Bengal, industry partners eminent people and academia, industry and civil society.

Presently, the institute is being mentored by Indian Institute of Technology Kharagpur with Prof. Partha P. Chakrabarti, Director, IIT Kharagpur as our Mentor-Director and Prof. Anupam Basu, Director of NIT Durgapur as Executive Director/Professor-In-Charge.

IIIT Kalyani has been attributed the status of Institute of National Importance (INI) by the cabinet in March 2017. While construction has started in the land provided, the institute is presently running from the temporary campus at Webel IT Park, Kalyani.




Training & Placement

The institute has a very active Training and Placement cell which looks into the placement for it's students. The objective of the institute training and placement cell is to help student's identify their career goals and provide an edge into the present day competitive job market. The scope of work of Placement Cell extends from organizing personality enhancement and career development workshops to providing internships to students in various organizations and preparing students for the final placement. For the first batch of students around 14 companies had conducted interviews (on campus/online) and the offers received is 85% of the total number of students. The offers were received from various reputed companies/institutes such as NDL, FOSSEE, Smartprix, Mihup, Infologitech, Sparrow etc.

The institution encourages and facilitates internships in reputed industry houses during their vacation. In addition the institute also undertakes joint programs with industry to facilitate collaboration with the industry. All students of 1st batch (2014-2018) were offered internships in reputed organizations like, IISc Bangalore, IIT Kharagpur, IIT Bombay, C-DAC Kolkata, C-DAC Pune, VECC Kolkata, SNLTR Kolkata, SkyBits Technologies Pvt. Ltd. They are working in national level projects like National Digital Library, FOSSEE and others.

100% of the Second batch of students(2015 - 2019) who are currently in thier 3rd year are also pursuing internships in reputed institutes like IIT Kharagpur, IIT Patna, NIT Durgapur, NIT Kurukshetra, C-DAC Pune etc.



To highlight about student-industry interaction, the end of 3rd, year students from at undergraduate engineering streams for a summer internship as a part of the course curriculum. This summer internship programme helps the industries to harness our talents. It is my pleasure to introduce TPC which looks after the placement activities of the studen,ts at IIIT Kalyani. We have the required facilites to conduct placement sessions, video conferencing etc. to organize campus placement activities. 




Placement Status 2017-18

REGULATORY RULES

HOSTEL

All the hostels are equipped with WiFi and 24 Hrs security.
