#### Members Absent

## 1) Mr. S. N. Datta, Registrar (Offg.).

At the outset, Chairman extended a hearty welcome to the members present and placed a proposal to include the name of Prof. Sriman Kumar Bhattacharyya, Deputy Director of IIT Kharagpur & immediate past Mentor Director of IIIT Kalyani to be a member of the Senate. He also briefed the members about the present academic status of IIIT Kalyani and about the missing boy Raj Shree Gupta, Reg no. CSE/18065/376.

Other members of the Senate unanimously accepted the proposal including the name of Prof. Sriman Kumar Bhattacharyya as a special invitee for all upcoming Senate meetings.

The agenda items were taken up and the following resolutions were taken:

## Item number 1: Action taken report to the Senate in respect of last Senate meeting.

Chairman Senate informed that no comments were received from the members of the Senate on the minutes of 1<sup>st</sup> Senate meeting. The minutes of the 1<sup>st</sup> meeting of the Senate of IIIT Kalyani held on 19<sup>th</sup> October 2019 was confirmed. Action taken were discussed and ratified with a few suggestions as mentioned below.

Item number 5 of 1<sup>st</sup> Senate meeting: Starting of M. Tech. and/or B. Tech.(ECE) courses from next academic year.

Due to COVID 19 pandemic, construction of new campus is delayed and thus Institute is not ready to start any new courses in the coming session 2020-2021. Faculty Coordinator in collaboration with the CSE/IT and ECE faculty members will submit the requested documents for starting of M. Tech and/or B. Tech. (ECE) in upcoming Senate meeting for approval. The Senate noted and suggested exploring the possibility of dual degree M. Tech in CSE & ECE.

Item number 10 of 1<sup>st</sup> Senate Meeting: To consider revision of academic curriculum as suggested by Governing Body to implement full six-month internship for the students and to frame its modalities.

Implementing full six-month internship for the students having CGPA more than 7.5 - Most of the companies currently offer six-months internship with stipend during the final (8<sup>th</sup>) semester to the students. On Senate's approval, Institute offered the same to 2016-2020 batch of students. Many companies approached through campus and off campus for selecting students. Students having CGPA more than 7.5 till 7<sup>th</sup> semester were allowed to appear for the process.

A total of 32 students out of 60 were finally approved to appear for the internships from the institute. They were asked to appear for the mid semester examinations online and for final semester examinations they were supposed to appear physically.

The Senate noted the action taken and suggested exploring the possibility of six month internship/summer training for all the final year students irrespective of CGPA, as this internship/preplacement offer is very vital in respect of today's job scenario. The Senate also suggested exploring multidisciplinary Internship.

Senate also suggested organizing webinar or workshop in collaboration with industry partners during later part of this year 2020 or early part of the next year 2021 especially exploring M. Tech course curriculum at par with industry requirement and internship/summer training/pre-placement offers for final year undergraduate students.

Faculty feedback mechanism - Faculty coordinator presented the faculty feedback form and the Senate suggested a few modifications, and asked to place in next meeting for approval.

Item number 11 of 1<sup>st</sup> Senate meeting: To consider and nominate two faculty members on the Governing Body.

The Senate was informed about the 9<sup>th</sup> meeting of Governing Body held on 25<sup>th</sup> February 2020 where Senate nominated senior most faculty members Dr Uma Das and Dr Imon Mukherjee are approved as a member of Governing Body. The Senate congratulates them.

# Item number 2: Report to the Senate about achievements of Faculty members and Students of IIIT Kalyani.

The Senate was informed about the achievements of Faculty members and Students of the IIIT Kalyani annexed in **Annexure A**. The Senate noted and appreciated the same.

Item number 3: Ratification of Ordinance applicable to B. Tech degree program offered at IIIT Kalyani. Section A: Pertaining to Credit Based Continuous Assessment and Award (CCLCAA) Ordinance, and Section B: Pertaining to Admissions, Program Layout and Examinations (APE) Ordinance..

Ordinance applicable to B. Tech degree program (Annexure B) was placed for ratification/approval. The Senate ratified the same.

## Item number 4: Degree with distinction, Certificate format to be approved.

During the last Senate meeting held on 19<sup>th</sup> October, 2019, Members proposed two options for the same B. Tech with distinction or B. Tech with honours. Senate advised the nomenclature to be decided in next Senate meeting after checking with other IIITs.

**Resolution**: The Senate advised the nomenclature to be B. Tech with honours for the student scoring a DGPI of 7.5 or above but less than 8.5 having not more than two backlog courses in the entire eight semesters.

Senate advised the nomenclature to be B. Tech with Distinction, when a student scores a DGPI of 8.5 or above and no backlog courses in the entire eight semesters.

Due to COVID 19 worldwide pandemic none of the students were physically present in the Institute campus. In this situation it was quite difficult to start the Summer Semester from this summer break as it is completely new concept for our students. It was placed to the Senate for approval of not offering Summer Semester this year.

  - i) Manas Kumar Ray, PhD/CSE/18004/303, Institute Enrolment date 19th July, 2018, supervisor Dr Sanjoy Pratihar and co-supervisor Dr Oishila Bandyopadhyay. Not reporting for last two semesters. Only appeared in Comprehensive viva in December 2019 and performed poorly (raised health issues).
  - ii) Mr. Susobhan Ray, PhD/ECE/18011/310, Institute Enrolment date 19th July, 2018, supervisor Dr Uma Das and co-supervisor Dr Tamal Ghosh (External, IIEST Shibpur). One coursework paper pending, not reported to Dr Das and Dr Ghosh in the last two semesters. He was completing the time allotted for course work (2 years) in July 2020. If he is not responded, he will be discontinued.

# Item number 15: Confirmation for the mode of mid semester and end semester examination for the 8th semester students for the current academic year and next onwards.

Due to the special permission of six month internship a few students of fourth year complained about two ways of examination/evaluation system. One rule applicable for the students having CGPA above the cut-off and getting change for six month internship and another rule for rest of the students of fourth year doing regular classes. The SENATE is requested to elucidate the two systems and direct to resolve the grievance.

Resolution: Senate dismiss the objection on examination procedure and instructed to follow the two separate procedures. Students opted/allowed six month internship will be evaluated mid semester online and other regular students have to appear physical examination during Mid Semester. All the final year students, whether doing six month Internship or not, will have to be present at Institute during End Semester Examination for written test, practical, project presentation comprehensive viva and other.

# Item number 16: What strategy should have to follow for next semester's classroom teaching due to the COVID pandemic?

Maintaining physical distance after COVID-19 pandemic will be a big challenge for class room teaching, the class strength of 50 students or more will be difficult to manage. An advice for Mode and Working Strategies was requested from the SENATE in this regard.

**Resolution :** The Senate advised conducting the coming semester online till the COVID – 19 pandemic situation resolves.

# Item number 17: Decision regarding convocation for the batch (Reg session 2016-17) graduating in the year 2020.

Resolution: The Senate advised to schedule 2<sup>nd</sup> Convocation for the students (registration batch 2016 – 17) in the month of January 2021 under the supervision of Dr Dalia Nandi and Dr Sanjay Chaterji (Convocation In-charge 2019-20).

# Item number 18: Disciplinary Committee report for consideration and approval of the Senate.

**Resolution :** The Senate ratified both the minutes of the Institute Malpractice Committee dated 20<sup>th</sup> July, 2019 and 04<sup>th</sup> January, 2020 (Annexure J.1 and J.2).

#### Item number 18: Any other matter with the permission of the chair.

#### (1) Case of Manish Tomar (Reg#149).

The Senate has been informed that by the instruction of the Mentor Director and the Executive Director during the meeting dated 31-05-2020, Examination cell has taken special care to identify 4th year students who are very near to graduating but have a few backlogs from earlier semesters. In this regard, it was noticed that MANISH TOMAR (Reg #. 149) has only ONE backlog from subjects offered during Autumn 2019. The course was MA101 (Mathematics-I). To avoid the student's wait for supplementary exams (which are uncertain in the current COVID situation), a special request was placed to Dr. Anirban Lakshman, course instructor. He contacted the student and took a special online exam (analogous to an early supplementary). The student has been graded and awarded a 'P' grade.

The same is placed to the Senate for approval so that the student, Manish Tomar, graduates along with other students. This has been done for the benefit of the student as per the instruction of the Executive Director and the Mentor Director.

**Resolution:** The Senate noted and instructed to recheck other fourth year students in same line. The Senate approved the case of Manish Tomar.

## II) JEE Main Examination -

Resolution: Conducting JEE Main Examination in Institute campus during this pandemic time is not possible due to rented building, presence of other small entrepreneur inside the same campus and less number of manpower present in Kalyani. Hence Senate decided to opt out from giving campus as Examination center for JEE Main examination this year.
