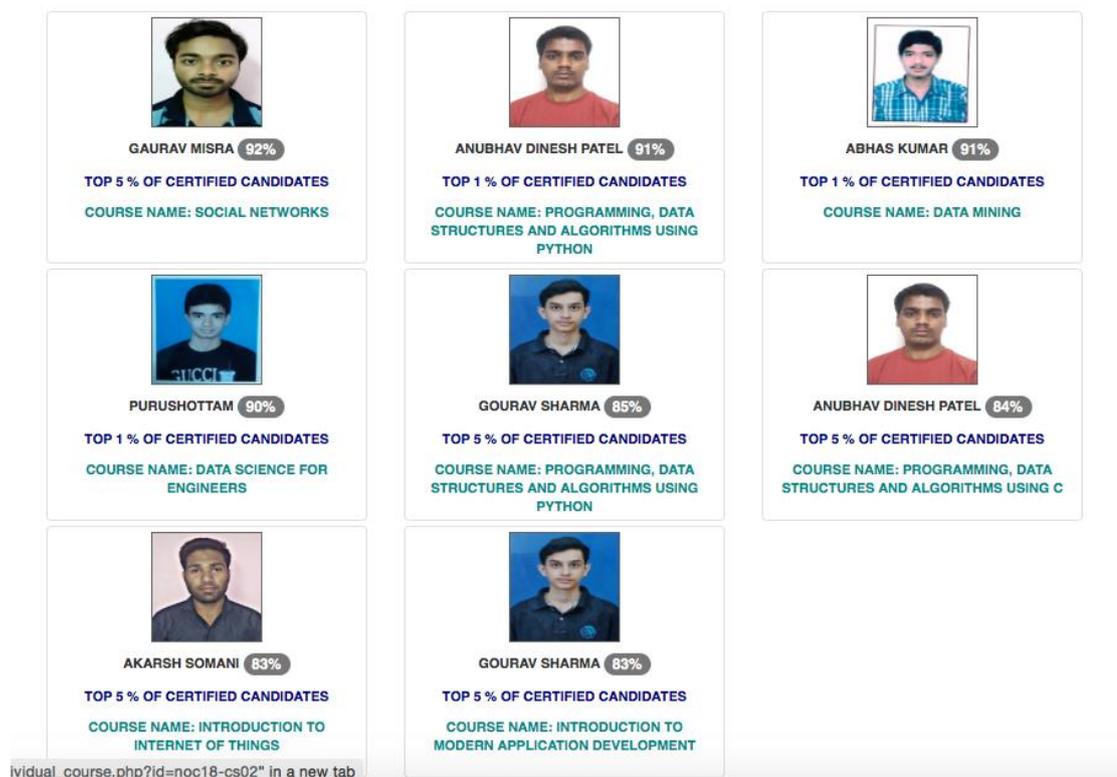


Figure 2: NPTEL achievers
